## **BOOST UP CELEBRATION!**

Hello,

Last week, we wrapped up our two weeks of Boost Up sessions aimed at getting our students ready for the 2023-24 school year. These days are an important part of building skill and fluency in Mathematics and Reading. Now it's your turn to support our efforts in reading by

- Read to your child and model fluent reading.
- Have your child read for one minute and count the number of words they read. Track their progress.
- Read along with your child (Choral Reading).
- Have your child read to you and mark the words they miss on a separate copy. Practice those words again.
- Re-read their favorite books.

Strategies for improving mathematics skill and fluency are

- Practice math facts in everyday life. Count the visible objects along the side of the road when driving with your child.
- Use a deck of cards and ask your child to add or subtract two cards together. Older grades can add multiplication to the mix!
- Check out Xtramath on the web for additional fun ways to build math skills.

Most important is the belief that every child can learn and learning is fun. Your actions and encouragement speak more than words to your child about the importance of math and reading in the everyday lives.
