<p><b>Wisconsin TIP (Talent Incentive Program) Grant</b></p>	<p>The TIP grant aids low-income and disadvantaged Wisconsin students with additional college funding to help reduce the student’s amount of loan, work-study, or unmet need.</p> <p><b>Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students must be a first-time freshman.</li> <li>● Students must be attending a public or private Wisconsin college or university.</li> <li>● A student must meet one criteria from Group A based on financial need and one criteria from Group B based on nontraditional/ disadvantaged circumstances (SHS fits group B).</li> <li>● The TIP grant can be renewed for up to ten semesters of enrollment and must be used within six years of enrollment at a public, private, or technical college or university in Wisconsin.</li> <li>● Funds are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis.</li> <li>● <a href="https://dpi.wi.gov/weop/tip-grant">https://dpi.wi.gov/weop/tip-grant</a></li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>The scholarship pays for the cost of registration, books, supplies, room, and board.</b></p>
